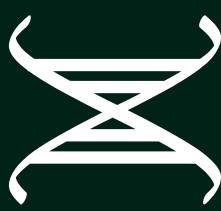
The FEAST project aims to catalyze the transition to a healthy and sustainable food system across Europe.
